Obstacles (What skills/tools/knowledge do you need to reach your goals?)

Recreational Activities (How will you spend your free time?)

Include:

10-15 pictures (drawn, printed, photos, magazine clippings, etc.)

At least two quotes, verses, or lyrics

Size:

No smaller than a standard sheet of paper

No larger than a regular poster board

Due date:

The 2nd Wednesday of the school year.
